Government to Commercialise Tech Platforms

MIMOS technology platforms have been transferred to ten Malaysian companies for product development.

Ten Malaysian companies have been given an opportunity and assistance to develop technology products for the global market by government applied research agency MIMOS.

MIMOS President and Chief Executive Officer, Dato' Abdul Wahab Abdullah, said that the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), through MIMOS, has exchanged memorandums of agreement with 10 recipients from various local industries to develop products based on MIMOS technology platforms.

"MIMOS technology platforms developed at our labs continues to gain momentum from the indigenous industries,"

said Wahab. "The transfer of MIMOS technology platforms is a testament to the value-add that they can bring to the technology recipients by enhancing their existing products and services, giving them a competitive edge in the challenging market space."

MIMOS is an applied research organisation in information & communication technologies dedicated to growing globally competitive indigenous industries. MIMOS pursues exploratory and industry-driven applied research through multi-stakeholder partnerships

with universities, research institutes, government agencies and industries focused on frontier technologies.

Licensing for Globalisation

"Through MOSTI's technology licensing programme, MIMOS is helping to bolster the growth of globally competitive local companies and indigenous industries through its research and development in frontier technologies," said Wahab. "MIMOS' focus is on strategic market-driven product development and advanced technology,

which essentially involves the development of technology platforms for commercialisation by indigenous industries.
